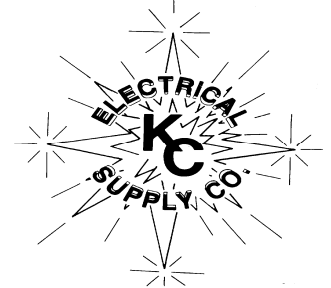

Project Sales Tax Exemptions

During our recent sales tax audit by the state of Kansas, we discovered that the state of Kansas does not recognize Missouri Project Exemption certificates. If you are doing a job in Missouri and you have a Missouri Project Exemption, the material must be picked up from or delivered to a location in Missouri. If the material is picked up or delivered to a location in Kansas (like your shop or storage facility), even though the job site is in Missouri, the material is subject to the appropriate Kansas tax.

The auditors are also watching very closely the project exemption expiration dates. If material is purchased after the expiration date, it is subject to tax. Please watch the expiration dates closely. If you believe that you will need to buy material after the expiration date, file for an extension with the state of Kansas.

Missouri does reciprocate with Kansas, meaning if you have a Kansas Project Exemption, Missouri does recognize the certificate and will exempt taxes, even if material is picked up or delivered to Missouri.

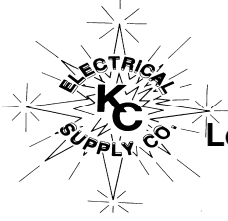
